Cave bus

New wood policy

Whiteley Woods has an abundance of trees, some of which occasionally need to be pruned or cut down, often due to weather damage. This provides quite a large amount of wood which can then be used for fires on site.

We are introducing a wood policy that will enable us to provide groups with dry seasoned wood throughout the year. From October 2023, there will be clear identifiable wood which is ready to burn. This will be stored in the wood store. There will also be stacks of wood at various places throughout the centre that is 'seasoning'. Please don't use this as it is still wet and won't burn.

If you are unsure as to which wood to use, please ask. As usual, there will also be fallen limbs and branches which can be collected by groups using the site.

Keeping the OAC tidy

A reminder for all our users, please remember to tidy and check the backwoods area before your group leaves.

We love having our Woodland Kindergarten on site during the week and we need to keep the space looking welcoming for all.

Latest on the Youth Investment Fund award
