Children become Space Explorers or Time Travellers and take part in fun activities designed to encourage curiosity, creativity, and connection with nature.



Activities support classroom learning for each year group (1-6) in National Curriculum KS 1 & 2 core and foundation subjects.



Resources to support teacher-led delivery include workbooks, session plans and knowledge organisers.



Developed in collaboration with Curriculum Development and Outdoor practitioners, and with researchers from the University of Sheffield's School of Education.



Affordable costs, and accessible by public transport from most areas of the city.

This helps the area remain wealthy in diverse nature. We were greatly pleased to be able to contribute to this amazing site, and we hope that other people will find as much joy here as we did."
