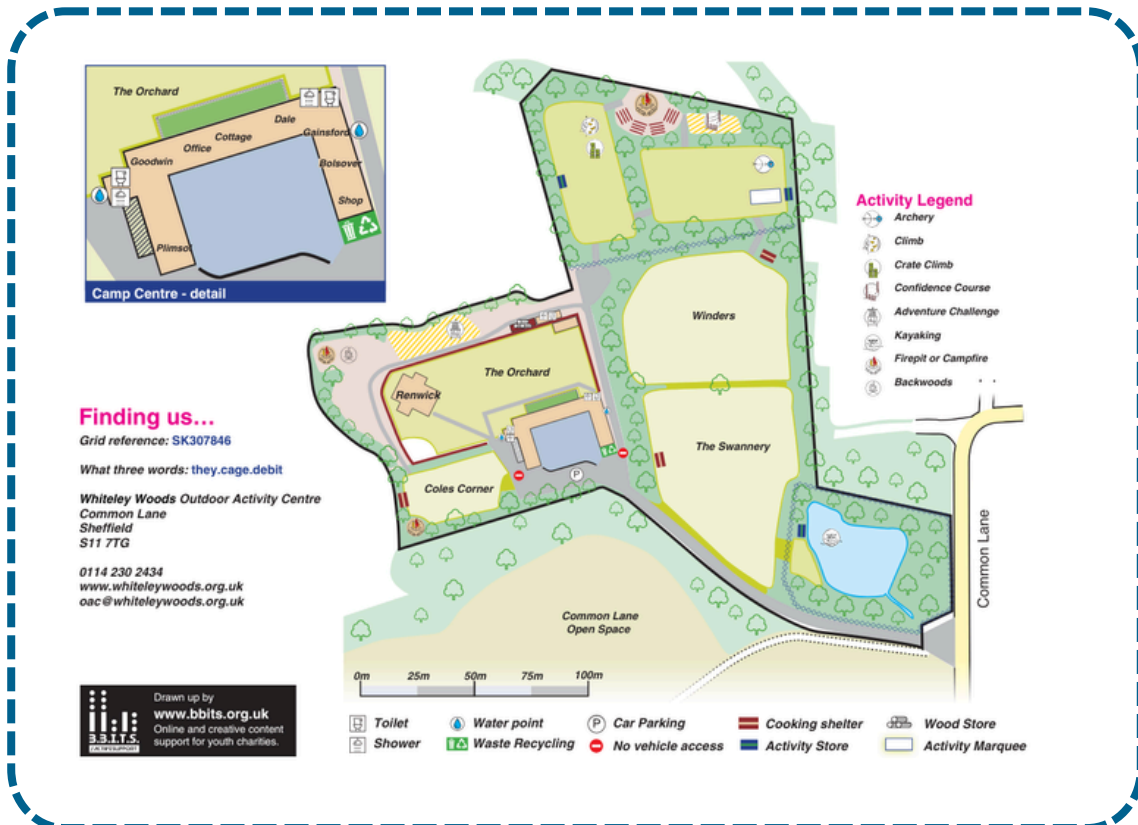

# STAYING SAFE

at Whiteley Woods OAC

**Listen to your leaders** and activity instructors. If you don't understand, ask!

**If you hear a fire alarm** listen to instructions from adults and go to the Fire Assembly Point.

**If someone gets hurt** or if something gets broken, tell an adult.

**Be extra careful** around roads and fires.

**Make sure** you wear the right clothes and footwear for your activity.

**No ENTRY**

**Don't go** anywhere on site that you haven't been told you can go.

**Be responsible** for your own, your friends, and other people's safety!

Our buildings are called Plimsoll, Renwick and Goodwin Cottage.



They all have a kitchen, where groups can cook their food and make drinks.



They have dorms with bunk beds where you will sleep, and they have washrooms with showers, sinks and toilets.
