STAYING SAFE

Listen to your leaders and activity instructors. If you don't understand, ask!

If you hear a fire alarm listen to instructions from adults and go to the Fire Assembly Point.

If someone gets hurt or if something gets broken, tell an adult.

Be extra careful around roads and fires.

Make sure you wear the right clothes and footwear for your activity.

Our buildings are called Plimsoll, Renwick and Goodwin Cottage.



They all have a kitchen, where groups can cook their food and make drinks.



They have dorms with bunk beds where you will sleep, and they have washrooms with showers, sinks and toilets.



They have a space that can be used for eating, doing activities, and spending time together.



Our campsites are called The Orchard, Winders, The Swannery and Coles Corner.
